

ENfold - Workshop 1: ENgage

About the event:

At EnactusPESU, we actively and consistently work towards developing innovative and sustainable projects that hold a great deal of social importance and pride ourselves in being another chapter of a global community of social entrepreneurship. With these goals acting as an usher, upskilling the members of our club and the students of our university at large will always possess great merit. In order to achieve this as well as to incorporate ideas of networking and peer-to-peer learning, we are planning to organize a series of workshops under the name “ENfold”, the first of which will be called “ENgage” which proposes to introduce its participants to themes such as ideation and identifying problem statements in social entrepreneurship, networking and peer learning.

Tentative Structure of The Event:

1. SE Talk 1: Finding a Problem Statement

- **Duration:** 60 minutes
- **Format:**
 - **Introduction to Enactus** (15 minutes)
 - **Discussion with Super Seniors** (45 minutes): Focus on how they selected their problem statements, including their interests and experiences, followed by an interactive Q&A session.
- **Networking Session** (30-45 minutes): Participants write down their top three problem statements/fields of interest, facilitating discussions to form teams of up to six members, prioritizing collaboration among strangers.

2. Follow-Up Activities

- **Google Form Submission:** In the same week, participants submit their problem descriptions and proposed tech solutions.
- **Subsequent SE Talks:** Build on the tech stack most commonly used in the submitted projects.

Benefits and expected outcome:

ENgage fervently strives to impel young minds to ideate and innovate their thoughts. Participants will stride through a horizon that unfolds right techniques of ideation and keys to articulate potential social problems. Through this, our commitment to stand by innovation and social impact is exemplified. Upskilling is a pivotal goal of these workshops. A platform to establish connections with industry partners along with peer-to-peer networking promotes exhilarating internship opportunities and sturdy future collaborations. Fostering an interdisciplinary approach to problem-solving, combining technical expertise with entrepreneurial mindsets, we aim to empower students to create meaningful solutions that address pressing social issues while enhancing their educational experience.
